

CUBA: EDUCATION, ART, AND NATURE

Get to know Cubans from all walks of life. This delegation is aimed at educators and others who want to visit and study Cuba's urban and rural educational programs from primary to university levels, including professional schools such as the Latin American School of Medicine and the National School of Arts. Included are meetings with professionals, families, elected officials, neighborhood organizing committees, and visits to artists' collectives, museums, and historical sites. Also included is a two-day visit to Matanzas province and the Zapata peninsula.

Participants in this delegation will:

- Examine Cuban national priorities, such as universal education and healthcare
- Discuss with Cubans the effects of recent changes in US and relations including the longstanding US.. Blockade on Cuba.
- Experience the sights, sounds, and tastes of old Havana, its neighborhoods, and the surrounding countryside.
- Visit the Bay of Pigs Museum & the National Park of Cienaga de Zapata, declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 2001.
